IEA Board members are volunteers and are committed to furthering the vision and mission of the IEA. Board service offers the opportunity to grow personally and professionally, to develop meaningful relationships with other passionate and motivated individuals, and to make a difference in the International Executives community.

A Board term is 2 years. Two IEA Board Members serve on the IEA Board of Directors from each of the three regions in the USA and Canada: West, Central, and East. The positions are volunteer, although some directors receive funding from their local Chapters.
